

# Southwest Women in Conservation

## Parking and Shuttle information:

Please park at the City of Santa Fe's Water History Park at the base of Upper Canyon Road (first parking lot on left after turning onto Upper Canyon Road - there will be signs). Complimentary shuttles will be available for guests throughout the event, starting at 12:30 pm to bring you to the Randall Davey Audubon Center. **Please try to arrive early, as we'd like to have our speakers begin at 1:30!** Shuttles will run through 5:00 pm. Riding time is about 5 minutes.

**The parking lot at the Randall Davey Audubon Center is small and can typically only accomodate our day visitors, not special events.**

### Directions to the Water History Park, Upper Canyon Road

*From I-25:*

*Take Exit 284, Old Pecos Trail.*

*Go north (turn left if you're coming from Albuquerque, or turn right if you're coming from Las Vegas or Clines Corners) on Old Pecos Trail.*

*Turn right to remain on Old Pecos Trail at the third light.*

*Turn right at Armenta (at stoplight).*

*Turn left at Camino Corrales.*

*Turn right at Old Santa Fe Trail.*

*After approximately a mile, turn left at Camino del Monte Sol.*

*Turn right on Camino Cruz Blanca.*

*Follow for less than a half mile until you pass St. John's College and the road turns left becoming Camino Cabra.*

*Follow to stop sign of Upper Canyon Road and Cristo Rey Street and turn right.*

*Take an immediate left into the parking lot at the Water History Park.*

*From Taos or northern part of Santa Fe:*

*Take U.S. 84/285 south.*

*On 84/285 stay right and follow signs for I-25*

*St. Francis Drive (the highway becomes St. Francis Drive).*

*Turn left on Alameda.*

*After approximately 2 1/2 miles Alameda will curve right and become Camino Cabra.*

*Go left at the stop sign of Upper Canyon Road and Cristo Rey Street.*

*Take an immediate left into the parking lot at the Water History Park.*
